We are excited to be able to offer the children in Year 4 the opportunity to visit The Living Rainforest in Berkshire to support our learning in both Science and Geography for next term. During the day, we will be exploring the rainforest and focusing on how plants and animals have adapted to suit living in a rainforest environment.

Date: Friday, 27 March 2026

Cost: £20.00 payable via Arbor.

No child will be excluded from this experience if parents cannot afford to contribute; however, if we receive insufficient contributions then we will have no option but to cancel this experience as we cannot provide trips and visits without parental contributions.

Time: Children will need to be in school as normal for us to **leave by 8:45 am** and we hope to be **back by 4:00 pm**.

Lunch: All children will require a packed lunch on this day. Please ensure your child has a water bottle and a lunch drink; however, no fizzy drinks are allowed. Lunches should be packed in a small named rucksack or lunch bag with a handle so the children can carry them easily. If your child is entitled to free school meals, please book a deli option on ScoPAY and this will be provided as a packed lunch for them to take on the visit.

Dress: The children will need to wear their normal school uniform on the day and be dressed appropriately to take advantage of the organisations outdoor play area over lunchtime. The session will involve a lot of walking, so please ensure your child wears appropriate shoes. We are sure that this will be an extremely worthwhile learning experience for your child and also lots of fun.
